Message from Paula concerning the lead in Ohio:

I want to update everyone on the Ohio situation. As many of you have heard, we had information that was coming from the area of Mansfield, Ohio, that lead us to believe that there was a possibility that Pam could be in that area. We felt it necessary for one of us to go to Ohio and personally check on these leads. Pam's husband, Don, made the trip and has followed up on all the tips and information we had. He went into the mental health facility and met with the director and they assured him that Pam is not, and has not been, a patient there. He also met with the woman that felt she had seen Pam in another area just outside Mansfield, and that did not pan out either. He met with law enforcement and media and visited the homeless shelters in the area. Unless something further happens, he will return home this weekend. The Ohio lead is really the first and only lead we have had in the case since the first week in Panama City. We will continue our search efforts, sending out information constantly to shelters and hospitals and mental health facilities while also, trying to get Pam listed with as many missing persons agencies and websites as we possibly can. I want to thank everyone for continuing to keep Pam and her family in your thoughts and ask that you would also continue to keep Pam's information out there. We need as many people looking for her as we can get. We are most grateful for everyone's support.
